



UCD Collection Solution Test Environment

Overview

The Fannie Mae Uniform Closing Dataset (UCD) Collection Solution Test Environment (UCD CLVE) is available to support the rollout of the UCD Collection Solution enhancements. UCD CLVE mirrors the UCD production application. The UCD CLVE allows lenders and technology solution providers to test UCD XML files for import, as well as test for manual entry.

Getting Started

- Log into UCD CLVE, as follows:
 - Use your UCD production user ID/password to access UCD CLVE.
 - If you do not have access currently, and require access to UCD CLVE, have your Corporate Administrator request access for you through [Technology Manager](#).

NOTE: *In Technology Manager the Administrator will find the “UCD CLVE” link from the list of available applications; select this to provide access to users in your company. All users must have the UCD_SUBMIT role. You can provision the UCD_ADMIN role to users who initiate, approve, and view established relationships between a Correspondent and their Aggregator.*

- Once access has been granted by your administrator, log in with your UCD production user ID/password.
- If you do not know who your Administrator is, contact your Account Team representative or the Customer Contact Center.

Quick Tips for Testing

- Do not include a Casefile ID from Desktop Underwriter® (DU®) in a test file unless that Casefile ID is from a test DU environment. Fannie Mae does not link DU production with the UCD CLVE environment.
- If you are importing existing UCD XMLs that have a valid Casefile ID, you will need to remove the Casefile ID before you can import. To remove the Casefile ID, refer to the following scenarios in the [UCD Quick Guide: Casefile Identifier Scenarios](#):
 - Scenario 5: Loan was underwritten by another AUS (not DU)
 - Scenario 6: Loan was manually underwritten
 - Scenario 7: Loan was initially submitted to DU but was ultimately delivered as a manually underwritten loan
