Effective Date	Impacted Area	Description
May 23	Project Details Page	An icon will be added to the image at the top of the Project Details screen to display the number of approved phases. This will help Lenders quickly identify if there is an approved phase within the project regardless of the entire project having a Fannie Mae Status or not.
May 23	CPM Certified Project Reports	A non-disclosure notice will be added to the CPM Reports screen and on the downloaded version of each report. As a reminder, CPM reports are Fannie Mae Confidential and Proprietary information. The reports are intended solely for authorized users of CPM and lenders must maintain their confidentiality and may not further publish or produce them externally.
May 23	Certification Printout	The CPM user's email address, phone number, Delivery Type Codes, and User Agreement will be added to the certification printout.
May 23	Certification Question Updates	Minor updates will be made to the certification questions to further align with existing <i>Selling Guide</i> requirements and allowances.
