The APIs found on The Exchange[®] have been moved onto the Developer Portal and listed as Public APIs, and the platform will be retired. For API integration(s) previously built using The Exchange to continue functioning normally, they will need to be rebuilt using the Developer Portal **prior to March 3, 2023**.

- 2. Reset your password by clicking "Log In" within step 2, then click the "Forgot Password" link on the login page.
- 3. Once logged in, follow the steps "Create an app" and "Access data" to rebuild the integration.

Public APIs and instructions for integrating them are published on the Developer Portal. Existing integrations can be updated to maintain functionality beyond March 3, 2023.

March 3, 2023

Existing API integrations built on The Exchange must be updated on the Developer Portal by this date.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Developer Portal?

The Fannie Mae Developer Portal allows access to Fannie Mae mortgage and housing data through the Business Partner APIs and access to free housing and economic data through the Public APIs.

What are Public APIs?

Fannie Mae's Public APIs are open and available to the public and make analyzing housing data easier. These are the APIs formerly found on The Exchange[®].

What are Business Partner APIs?

These APIs are designed specifically for use by Fannie Mae approved seller and servicers and other business partners who transact mortgage loan business with Fannie Mae.

How will my existing API integrations from The Exchange be affected once the platform is retired?

Existing API integrations will continue to function normally until March 3, 2023. Users are required to follow the below steps to rebuild their integrations after November 18:

- 1. Go to the <u>Developer Portal user guide</u>.
- 2. Reset your password by clicking "Log In" within step 2, then click the "Forgot Password" link on the login page.
- 3. Once logged in, follow the steps "Create an app" and "Access data" to rebuild the integration.

New Developer Portal users and existing The Exchange users should follow the steps outlined on the user guide for Public Users.
