



Maintenance and Security Updates to Pricing & Execution - Whole Loan Integration Impact Memo

NOTE: On June 6, 2018 this document was updated to reflect a change in implementation dates.

Dear Integration Partner,

As part of maintenance and security updates, Fannie Mae will be disabling support of Transport Layer Security (TLS) version 1.0 and 1.1 protocols from its web servers. TLS 1.0 will be retired on Aug, 15, 2018 and TLS 1.1 will be retired shortly after. Going forward, **TLS version 1.2** will be the only supported protocol.

TLS 1.0 will be disabled in Integration on July 15, 2018 and Production on August 15, 2018.
