

B2B Gateway Integration Impact Memo

Update to Authentication Mechanism on the B2B Gateway

Dear Integration Partner:

We are updating the internal authentication mechanism for integration requests coming into the B2B Gateway (B2BG) for the Uniform Closing Dataset (UCD) Collection Solution and Collateral Data Delivery Service (CDDS) applications.

- **UCD Collection Solution** – Our web-based collection solution supports delivery of the Uniform Closing Dataset (UCD) XML file. In addition to testing and accepting the UCD XML file for delivery to Fannie Mae, this service offers an efficient way to receive data quality and eligibility feedback messages based on the UCD data provided.
- **CDDS** – This Uniform Collateral Data Portal (UCDP) back-end service allows mortgage insurers to retrieve Collateral Underwriter (CU) risk scores, flags and messages.

Impact:

- All UCD and CDDS direct B2BG integration traffic will be routed through the new authentication mechanism.

How will this affect my integrated system?

There is no impact to existing users who have access to the UCD Collection Solution (UCD) and/or (CDDS) direct B2BG integrations.

New users will be required to have an additional role associated with their User ID. This new role, `AllowBasicAuth_B2BGateway_FCP`, will be available for selection within Technology Manager.

- To assign a new role to assign a role for a new user:
 - Administrators click the **Available Applications I Manage** panel
 - then click the application code **FMSSO** to assign to the user
 - In the Roles section, administrators select the role to assign to the user, **AllowBasicAuth_B2BGateway_FCP**, then click Add. This is an additional step for administrators to follow in granting user access to UCD/CDDS direct integrations.

Testing Expectations

We strongly encourage you to perform shakeout testing for UCD and CDDS direct B2BG integrations to ensure there are no impacts to your business.
