Message Manager As-Is Servicing Report Transition

When we introduced Fannie Mae Connect™, our goal was to streamline and centralize key Fannie Mae information and data from multiple reporting applications, making it easier to do business with us.

We've continued to evolve Fannie Mae Connect through regular updates, and we continue to centralize reporting by transitioning the Message Manager As-Is Servicing reports into the Report Center in Fannie Mae Connect. Moving the reports to Report Center will provide the following benefits to Servicers:

- Consistent means for accessing reports
- The ability to retrieve all Servicer data in a single request
- A central location for all Servicing Reports in the Loan Servicing report category
- The ability for Servicers to access their client's reports

Report Transition Schedule

Beginning in April 2018 and continuing through 2019, the Message Manager As-Is Servicer reports will be released into Report Center in roughly the following order:

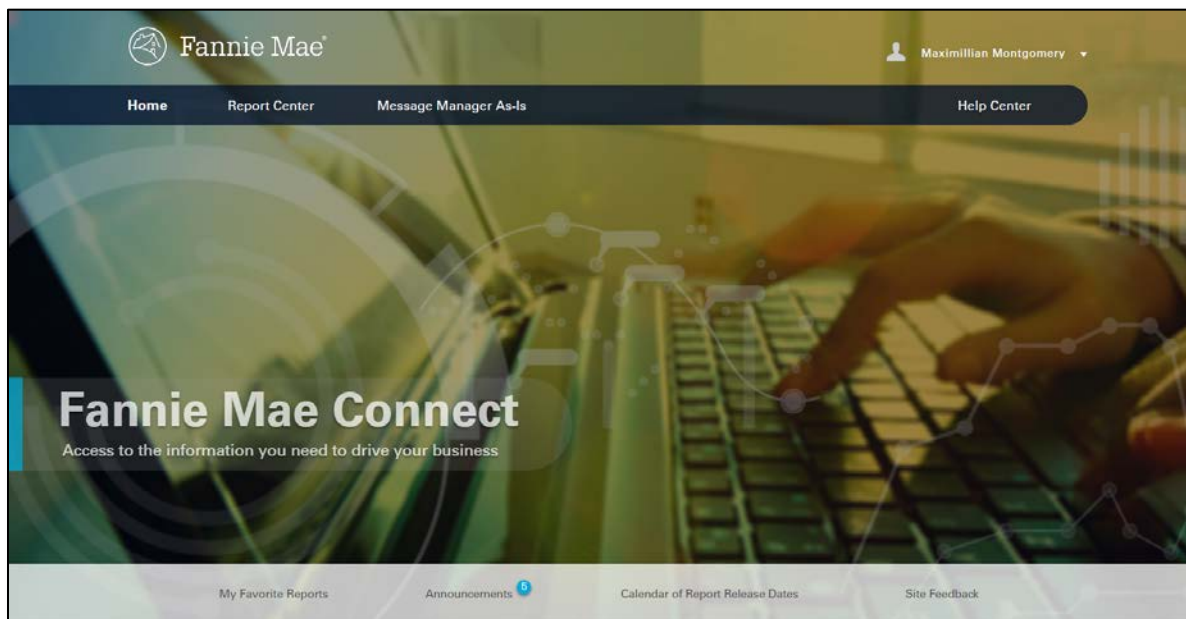




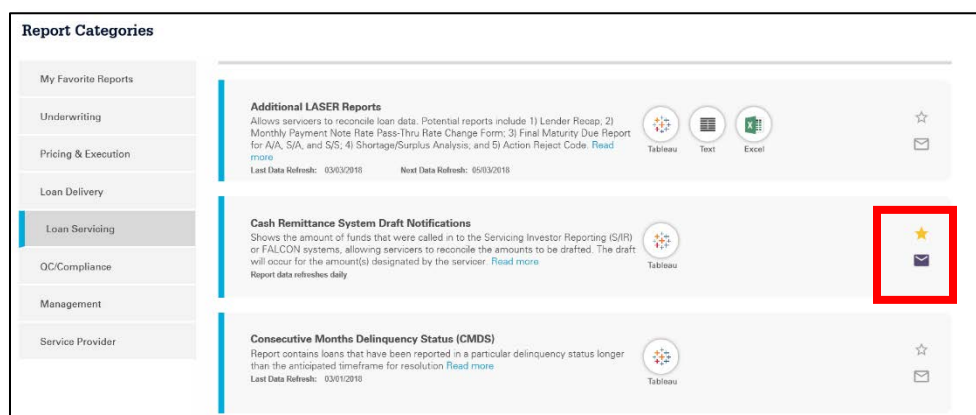
Report users will be notified when the reports are available in Report Center and will be provided with detailed technical specifications for the new report layouts. Users will have no less than 90 days to adopt the new report before the Message Manager As-Is version is retired.

Report Access

When the reports are released in Report Center they will be available in the Loan Servicing category on Fannie Mae Connect. Log on to Fannie Mae Connect today and make sure you have access to the Loan Servicing category in Report Center. If you do not, contact your company's Fannie Mae Report Administrator, found by viewing your profile when you click on your name in the upper right hand corner of the Fannie Mae Connect home page.



- You can easily tag reports as “Favorites” by clicking on the star to the right of the report description (star will turn yellow). You can remove a report from “Favorites” by deselecting the star (star will appear as a gray outline).
- Sign up to receive an email notification whenever a report has been updated. Click on the envelope to the right of the report description to enable and disable notifications. A purple envelope means that an email will be sent when the report has been updated.
