Credit Service Integration Impact Memo April Update

On **April 30, 2025,** Fannie Mae will implement an update to the Credit Service in the integration environment for both XIS direct integration and User Interfaces. This update will allow customers to pass the _Name attribute in the Service_Provider element with a valid Production affiliate name or number and their test credentials in the Control Input (CI).

Please refer to the table below for valid input:
