Domain Name System Infrastructure Update

What Is Changing

Fannie Mae is updating the Domain Name System (DNS) infrastructure that supports the XML Integration Service (XIS), which facilitates system-to-system connectivity with Fannie Mae's Desktop Underwriter® (DU®), Desktop Originator® (DO®), and EarlyCheck™.

While the production endpoint (direct.efanniemae.com) will remain unchanged, the associated IP address mappings will be updated during the standard maintenance window from 1 a.m. to 5 a.m. EST on Sunday, February 1, 2026. Any allow lists based on IP addresses related to the above-mentioned applications will need to be changed in conjunction with this update. An allow list is a method used to control network access by permitting only a certain set of trusted IP addresses.

Actions You Should Take

Strongly Encouraged

- Confirm with your integrated partners that any allow lists based on IP addresses will be updated during the standard maintenance window on Sunday, Feb. 1, 2026 from 1 a.m. to 5 a.m. ET to ensure your connectivity remains uninterrupted.
- If you manage your own allow lists using IP addresses, please contact [Fannie Mae's Integration Support team](#) for additional information on how to receive and test the updated IP addresses.

Recommended

- Direct integration users should leverage the Fully Qualified Domain Name (FQDN) direct.efanniemae.com for any allow list used during connectivity. If your organization is not able to allow lists using the FQDN, then please contact [Fannie Mae's Integration Support team](#).
