



# Supplemental Consumer Information Form Update

May 3, 2022

At the direction of the Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA), Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac (the GSEs) are announcing that the Supplemental Consumer Information Form (SCIF Fannie Mae/Freddie Mac Form 1103) will be a required document in the loan file for new conventional loans sold to the GSEs with application dates on or after March 1, 2023.

Although the GSEs previously communicated that the SCIF is not required, we are making this change to facilitate the collection of borrower preferred language, applicable homeownership education, and housing counseling details. Each GSE will publish a Guide Bulletin/Lender Letter indicating this change in July 2022.

#### **SCIF** Documents

To accommodate these updated requirements, the GSEs have made limited changes to the form that was published in October 2021. The table below provides an overview of the SCIF changes.

Section	Description of Change
Instructions at the top of the form	Removed the following (last) sentence on the form: "The lender or the borrower may complete all or part of the SCIF at their discretion."
Footer	Updated the footer date to 05/2022

The updated English version of the SCIF has been posted on each GSE's respective multi-language and URLA webpages. The five translated versions (Spanish, traditional Chinese, Vietnamese, Korean, and Tagalog) of the form will be updated at a future date and published to FHFA's Mortgage Translations clearinghouse.

#### **AUS Specifications**

Each field on the SCIF will be supported in our respective automated underwriting system (AUS) datasets. The GSEs will update conditionality and add any missing data in our next scheduled publication for our AUS specifications targeted for the third quarter of 2022. The table below provides an overview of the AUS specification changes in BLUE that each GSE is planning to make to support the new SCIF requirements for those who want to implement the changes in advance of the next AUS specification publication.

The GSEs are making the following additions to the data we currently collect and aligning our specifications for this data. Existing GSE edits related to homeownership education and housing counseling data are not changing.
