



Uniform Closing Dataset (UCD) Toolkit

The below items should be completed in order to submit a UCD MISMO 3.3.0 file.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Register for UCD Access</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Register for the UCD collection solution using Technology Manager. Review the Quick Guide: Access to UCD for Non-Sellers for details. For assistance, call the Technology Support Center at 800-2FANNIE (800-232-6643). <p>There are two user roles for the UCD solution:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UCD_SUBMIT: Provides the capability to upload UCD files, search UCD files, and transfer a submitted UCD file to another party. Fannie Mae Sellers have access to the UCD_SUBMIT role using Loan Delivery credentials. Non-Sellers must request access. UCD_ADMIN: Provides the capability to establish and manage relationships between correspondents and aggregators who will share UCD data. Both Sellers and Non-Sellers must request access. <p>NOTE: <i>The UCD_ADMIN role should only be provisioned to a limited number of users. These are specific users in your organization who have the ability to initiate, approve, and view established relationships between correspondents and aggregators. These users should also request the UCD_SUBMIT role.</i></p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>Testing in UCD</p> <p>The Fannie Mae Uniform Closing Dataset (UCD) Collection Solution Test Environment (UCD CLVE) is available to support the rollout of the UCD Collection Solution enhancements. UCD CLVE mirrors the UCD production application. The UCD CLVE allows lenders and technology solution providers to test UCD XML files for import, as well as test for manual entry.</p> <p>NOTE: <i>You will need to request access to the UCD CLVE environment through Technology Manager. Refer to the UCD Collection Solution Test Environment located on the UCD Collection Solution page.</i></p>

Establishing Relationships for UCD Transfer

The UCD collection solution enables correspondent lenders to transfer UCD data to an aggregator. The two organizations involved in the UCD transfer transaction must have an established relationship in the UCD solution. Reference the [Relationships for UCD Transfer Quick Guide](#) for more details on this process.

Getting Started: Establish Relationships

- Step 1: Establish Relationship for Transfer Capability (*correspondent to aggregator*)
- Step 2: Initiate the Relationship

NOTE: *If multiple results display when searching by Lender Name, verify you chose the correct Seller/Servicer #. If the lender you are searching for is not found, contact them to ensure they have the UCD_SUBMIT role and verify their Seller/Servicer #. Note that a lender may have a prefix in their name (e.g., UCDP Only). Refer to the [Relationships Quick Guide](#) for additional details.*

- Step 3: Approve the Relationship

Transfer Capability: Correspondent to Aggregator

Once a relationship is established between two organizations in the UCD solution, either party can transfer a submitted UCD file to the other party. The correspondent can designate a Casefile ID and specific aggregator to transfer UCD data. Note that before you can initiate a transfer, you must first upload a UCD XML file. Transfer the UCD Submission

- Step 1: Upload the UCD XML File
- Step 2: Transfer of the UCD Data by the Correspondent
- Step 3: Using the Transfer Activity Tab to Search

Subsequent UCD File Transfer

Once a UCD file has been transferred to an organization, the organization will have the option to transfer a UCD file to a subsequent lender. For details on this process, reference the [UCD Transfer Quick Guide](#).

Transfer the UCD Submission

- Step 1: Lender A transfers the UCD File to Lender B
- Step 2: Lender B transfers the same UCD file to Lender C
- Step 3: Using the Transfer Activity Tab to Search

NOTE: *All three lenders will then have access to the UCD Findings Report, UCD XML file, and the embedded Borrower Closing Disclosures. The UCD Transfer Quick Guide will be updated with more information at a later date.*
