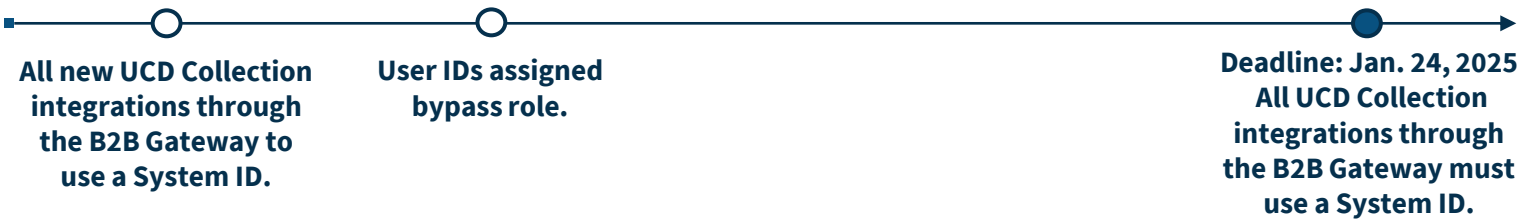


By January 24, 2025, Fannie Mae will require all existing UCD Collection integrations through the B2B Gateway to use a System ID. Mandating use of System IDs will enhance information security measures and improve management of credentials used to access Fannie Mae applications. This change is intended to provide better control and protection against unauthorized access of app-to-app interfaces.

The User IDs have been assigned the following FMSSO bypass role to allow time to convert to a System ID: "AllowEndUserID_loginto_B2BGatewayAWS_API".

FAQs

Q: What is a System ID?

System IDs are specifically used to facilitate system-to-system transactions. Application-to-application integrations, such as those that involve an [application programming interface \(API\)](#) or a [Loan Origination System](#), utilize System IDs.

Q: How System ID differs from User ID?

The key distinction between a System ID and a User ID is that a System ID cannot be used to access a Fannie Mae application's user interface (UI), whereas User IDs are used exclusively for that purpose. Also, an organization may assign a unique System ID to a system, job, or process, and requires a password reset every 365 days. In contrast, a User ID is assigned to an individual user and is intended to grant such user specific role access, and requires a password reset every 90 days.

Q: How to create a System ID?

Q: What do I need to know when creating a System ID?

When creating a System ID, you are required to provide a title and description that accurately characterizes your system and use case. Password management reminders will be sent to the email address that is linked to the System ID. We recommended the email address used be monitored, as passwords are required to be changed annually.

Q: Can I convert a User ID to System ID?

Yes, it is possible to convert your current User ID into a System ID. To do so, you must first contact your Fannie Mae representative and request an ID conversion.

Q: Does this new requirement affect integrations with third-party providers?

Yes, any app-to-app integrations involving Fannie Mae technology will require the use of a System ID.
